We are pleased to announce the 18th Workshop on Sustainable Horticultural Production in the Tropics. In this workshop original research and reviews of all topics regarding horticultural production can be presented, including marketing, socio-economic and environmental issues.

Besides, there will be a special topic on: **Strengthening theoretical research methods - Systems modelling**. Systems analysis refers to “a general methodology that applies a holistic perspective by taking all aspects of the situation into account, and by concentrating on the interactions between its different elements”. This approach provides a superior way of analysis problems and formulating research. The principles of systems and case studies will be covered during dedicated sessions during the workshop..

The abstract should contain the aim(s), methodology, results, discussion and conclusion. They should include the title, the name(s) of the author(s), affiliation, mailing address, e-mail address and telephone number(s). Authors should also state the sub-theme and indicate their preference for oral or poster presentation. The closing date for receiving revised abstracts shall be **October 15th, 2018**.
